

CHECKLIST CONTEXT

Consider the overall context checklist to expand on a situation analysis.

1. Context as the manner, position, or direction in which something is set.
2. Context as time or historical event, including time of day.
3. Context as physical location – country, city, suburb, etc.
4. Context as climate related location – desert, river, etc.
5. Context as climate conditions – sunny, raining, windy, etc.
6. Context as groups or entities.
7. Context as language or language groups.
8. Context as a wider paragraph or text that adds meaning to a part of the text.
